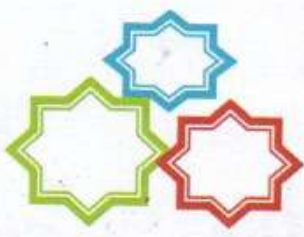

## Board Member's Foreword



Before registration, Trust has started a "Pilot Project" to create awareness of Information Technology and Computer Education in the interior and remote villages of Arunachal Pradesh and Assam, hence within a span of 5 years Trust has established 11 computer centers in the name and title of "Access - I.T. Education Academy" in different districts of Arunachal Pradesh and Assam trained almost 7000 candidates, later these computer centers (Access IT Education Academy) are taken over by Bethel Life Care Charitable Trust after registration of Trust on 2014.



## Our Intervention Strategies & Projects

### PAID COURSE

### Martha Nursing Training School

Auxiliary Nursery Midwifery in nursing course or A.N.M course is a diploma course. A.N.M course comes under medical nursing. A.N.M course duration is of 2 years including 6 months of the internship. The main aim of the course is to teach students to help the whole community of people in providing healthcare. This course has its importance because of the need for people having knowledge in the nursing profession. Any shortage in nurses will bring in A.N.M graduates to the limelight.

A.N.M course is available in both part-time as well as full-time. A.N.M course graduates get to work in all kinds of healthcare organizations. They have to treat patients, take care of their health and work on their rehabilitation.

Since 2015, Bethel is involved in imparting "Fundamental Nursing Care Training" to girls of Changlang District of Arunachal Pradesh, and also approached and processed to State Government relating to the essentiality of an ANM Nursing school in the territory of Changlang district as it is located at the edge of International border of China and Burma. Finally after availing NOC and Essentiality certificate from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh Trust has processed its file to Indian Nursing Council Delhi, Govt. of India and after inspection and formalities of 2 years on 17<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2017, Indian Nursing Council's Executive Committee approves "Martha Nursing Training School (a unit of BLC Trust) as an affiliated and recognized ANM Nursing school and stood 5<sup>th</sup> ANM Nursing school in entire Arunachal Pradesh.

## Course Conducted in 2018-19

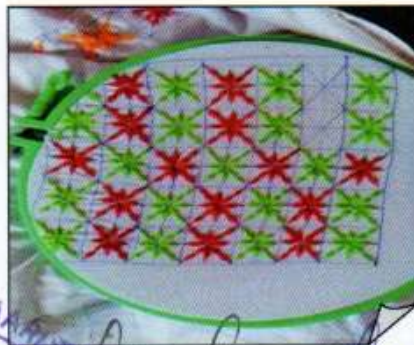
### Activity Outline:

Self Employed Tailor is a role of a self employed professional tailor who can sew and repair garments, made ups and home furnishing articles and manage livelihood out of it. The course involves 380 hours of classroom training followed by on-job training. In this year we have enrolled and trained 120 Beneficiaries in this project. Per batch 30 candidates participated in this course and above them 92.50 % passed out. After completion of course 74% of them had get their Placement in regarding sector.



### Measurable Impact of the Project

During this skill course our centre get a work order from local school to make school uniforms so we have engage our 04 self-employed tailor certified trainee with our faculty support to complete this task. 30 sets of units of uniform were prepared against which they got Rs.1100 per uniform. So it was really encouraging for our certified trainees to put effort to get such future work orders.

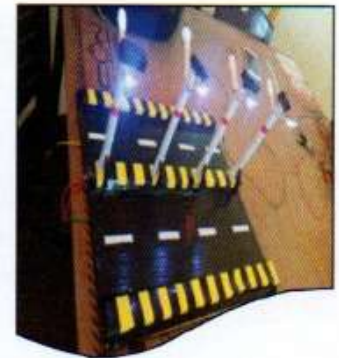

## Course Conducted in 2018-19

### Activity Outline:

This is a skill oriented course in the study of solar photovoltaic (PV) cells, modules, and system components; electrical circuits; PV system design and sizing for use in homes, commercial building etc and manage livelihood out of it. The course involves 440 hours of classroom training followed by on-job training. In this year we have enrolled and trained 120 Beneficiaries in this project. 30 candidates per batch were participated in this course, and 85 % out of 120 candidates passed out. After completion of course 71% of them had get their Placement in regarding sector.



### Measurable Impact of Project

This job-oriented course is designed with a proper balance of theory with practice, so that students get enough hands on experience. At the end of the course, students get an exposure to industrial standards. Some of our major recruiters were Geoplan Solution Pvt. Ltd. Dhanbad Jharkhand, ST Enterprise Namphai 2, Changlang, A.P., Access I.T. Education, Academy Kharsang, Changlang A.P., and E-Pakka Traders Balinong Kharsang Changlang A.P.

**Activity Outline :**

The General Duty Assistant (GDA) course trains students to work as nursing aides in hospitals, nursing homes and home care scenarios. As part of the curriculum, students learn how to provide basic nursing care and manage ill patients. The course involves 460 hours of classroom training followed by on-job training and manage decent livelihood out of it. In this year we have enrolled and trained 60 Beneficiaries in this project. 30 candidates per batch participated in this course and 93.33 % out of 60 candidates passed out. After completion of course 70% of them had get their job in regarding sector.



**Measurable Impact of Project :**

From this project, they have learned role of a basic health care provider. Some of our major recruiters were Sakara World Hospital Bengaluru, Pinewood Hospital Tinsukia Assam, Tree Hospitals Bengaluru, Rainbow Children's Hospital Bengaluru, V.G. Hospital Dibrugarh Assam and 402 Field Hospital Lekhapani Dist. Tinsukia Assam.

### **Skilling in Basic Tailoring of Local Women (Jairampur)**

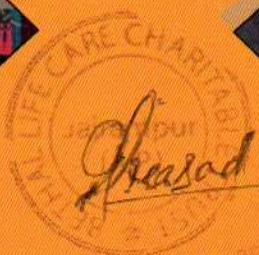
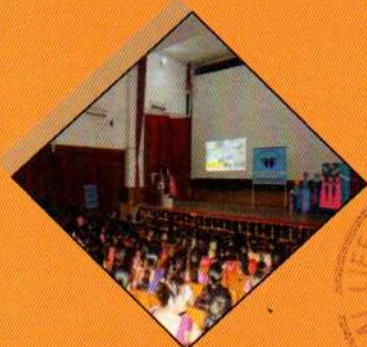

Choudhury, ADC, Jairampur. On this precious occasion Our Chief Guest presented their beautiful speech, In addition to the Nursing School, Jairampur gets Skill Development Centre. Skill development is one of focus sectors of the State Govt. I am very happy to inaugurate WSDC Jairampur for the people. Initially, the centre will offer Tailoring courses to the students. I am optimistic that the WSDC will play a pivotal role in creating self employment to the youths of the area.

**Project Outline:** Training offered, Diploma in Tailoring and the course involves 6 months duration of training. For this training 15 sewing machines installed in 600 sq.ft area of centre. We have enrolled and trained total 120 candidates in this course. 30 candidates per batch participated and learned about cutting, knitting, and Stitching and apparel design.

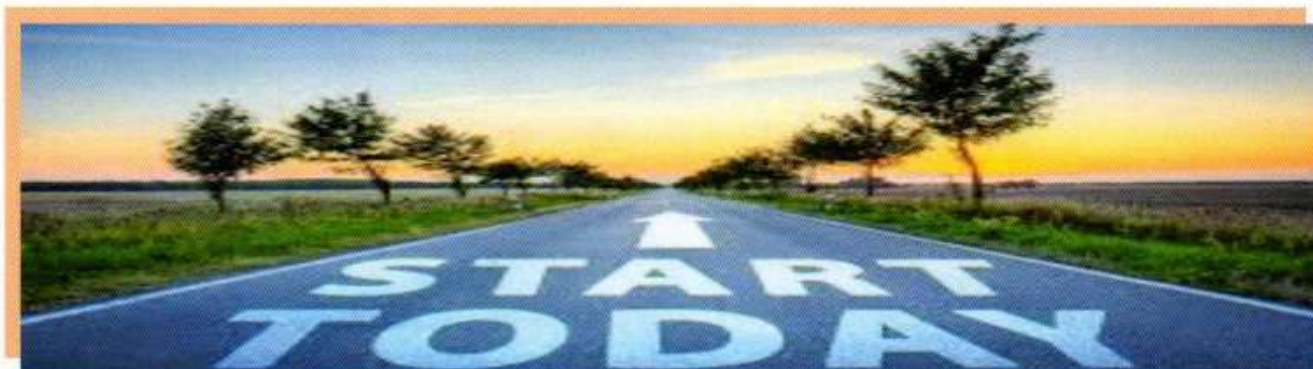

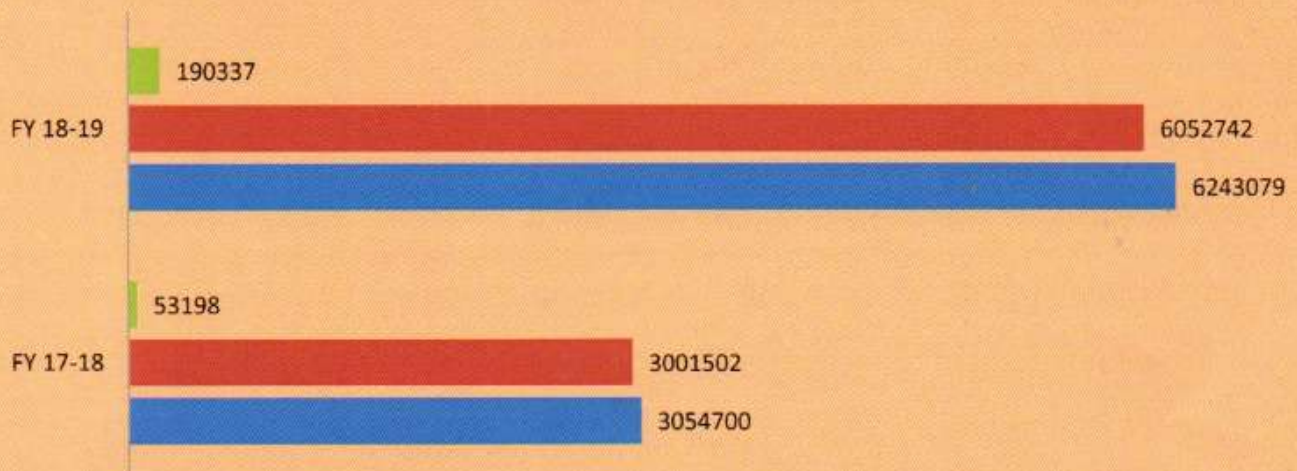
