Before registration, Trust has started a “Pilot Project” to create awareness of Information Technology and Computer Education in the interior and remote villages of Arunachal Pradesh and Assam, hence within a span of 5 years Trust has established 11 computer centres in the name and title of “Access – I.T. Education Academy” in different districts of Arunachal Pradesh and Assam trained almost 7000 candidates, later these computer centers (Access IT Education Academy) are taken over by Bethel Life Care Charitable Trust after registration of Trust on 2014.

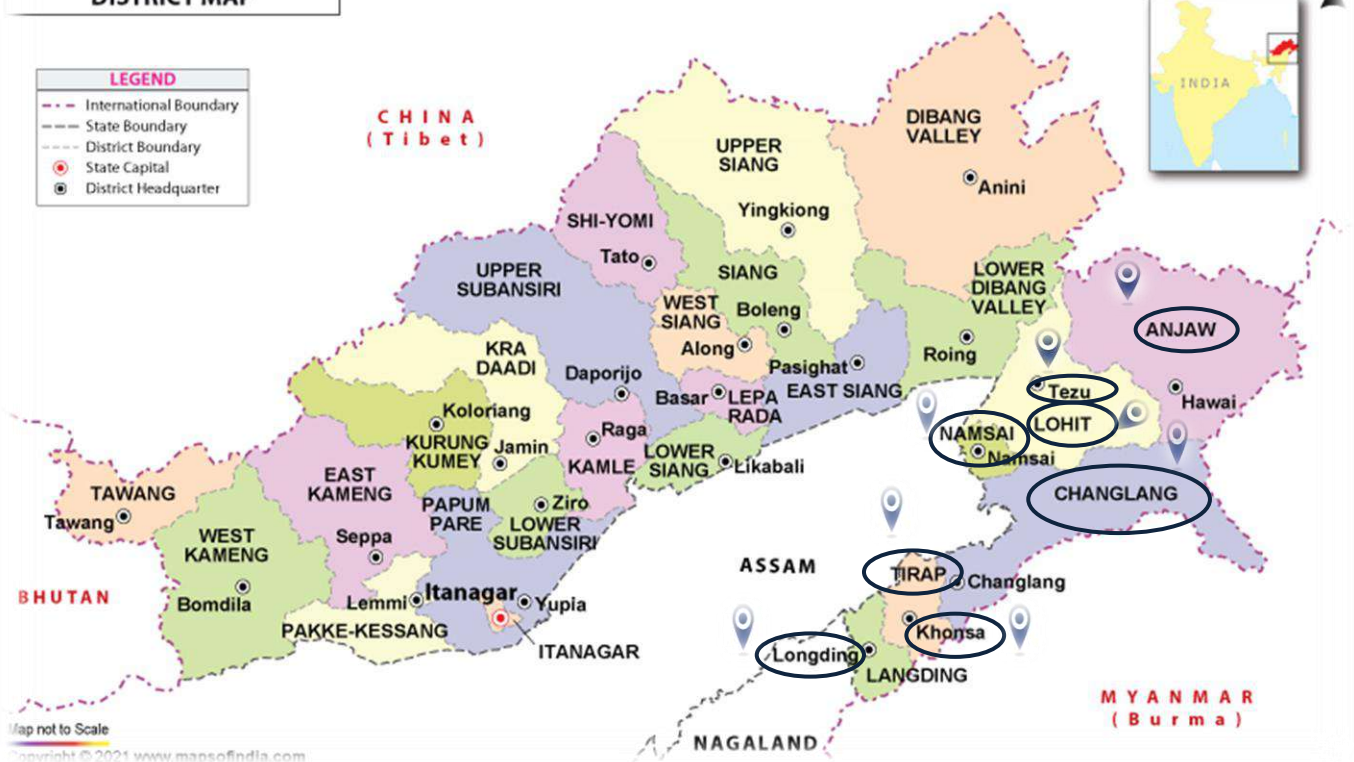

Activity Outline: LEDP envisaged the conduct of livelihood promotion programmes in clusters.

It was an intensive training for skill building, refresher training, backward-forward linkages and handholding as well as escort supports. It also encompassed the complete value chain and offers end-to-end solutions to SHG members. The tailoring kits were distributed to SHGs for undertaking “Sewing Machine Operator” training at Diyun, Changlang on 10th November 2022.

The SHGs members were undertaken batch-wise training under LEDP on “Tailoring” at Diyun, Dist. Changlang, Arunachal Pradesh. Now they are also trained in making “Low-cost cloth Bags to replace Plastic Bags” in the tune with Government initiatives to reduce the use of Single-use Plastics, which have low utility and high littering potential all across the area.

Advantages of cloth bags over plastic bags:

1. Cloth bags can be reused and recycled.
2. Non-toxic to the environment.
3. Highly cost-effective.
4. Cloth bags are stronger and can be used to carry weights.
5. Durable and long-lasting, unlike plastic and paper bags, which are easily torn.
6. Cloth bags can tolerate heat.
